

DESTINATION CORFU



CORFU'S ICONIC FORTRESSES

Then, towering above the northwest border of the capital is the 16th-century Neo Frourio (New Fort), an architectural masterpiece constructed by the Venetians.

KANONI AND MOUSE ISLAND


Visit two of the most famous landmarks of Corfu - the diminutive islands of Pontikonisi (Mouse Island and the islet of Vlacherna. Pontikonisi is just large enough to hold the impressive Pantokrator monastery. Nestled beside is, the famous islet Vlacherna, with its 17thcentury monastery dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Is connected to the mainland by a narrow causeway.

ACHILLION PALACE

The island's imperial past is one of the reasons it enjoys its reputation as one of Greece;s most glamorous destinations. This is why Empress Elizabeth of Austria-Hungary, the legendary Sissi, chose Corfu to build her spectacularly opulent palace. This elegant Pompeian-style building also has beautiful gardens where visitors can marvel at the famous statue of Dying Achilles.
